





HEADTEACHER'S NOTE

A few weeks ago, I sent a message to Year 6 parents about a WhatsApp group that some children were a part of. This seems to be very common, with some parents even supervising children's activity on their devices. However, in the past couple of weeks, teachers have dealt with several incidents where children have been unkind to each other on their devices, calling each other names and using derogatory language.

They have used apps like Snapchat and WhatsApp, which are not intended for children - Snapchat is rated 13+ and WhatsApp is for those aged 16+. I have attached information guides about WhatsApp and Snapchat which I would urge all parents to read. Please be vigilant when it comes to your child's online activities.

A REMINDER FROM THE OFFICE
