


English

- Solve fractions problems involving all four operations.
- Use formal written methods for the four operations.
- Name the different parts of a circle.
- Understand coordinates in 4 quadrants.
- Translate and reflect shapes.
- Identify negative numbers in context.
- Calculate the area of compound shapes.
- Calculate the perimeter of compound shapes.
- Convert between units of mass, length and capacity.
